This software will only run if the monitor is set at 256 colors. To reset your monitor:

Windows

- 1. Choose **Settings** from the **Start** menu.
- 2. Choose Control Panel.
- 3. Double-click on the Display icon.
- 4. Click on the **Settings** tab.
- In the Colors Palette drop-down menu, click on the arrow to show more settings.
- Click on 256 Color.
- 7. Click on Apply.
- Click on OK.

If the system asks whether you wish to restart your computer to accept these settings, click on **Yes.**
