## AMENDED INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

### MINIMUM SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

#### Windows

Windows 2000, 95, 98, NT 4.0  
IBM-compatible computer  
Pentium II processor (or equivalent)  
300 MHz  
96 MB (minimum) of RAM  
800 x 600 screen size  
Thousands of colors  
100 MB hard drive space  
12x CD-ROM drive  
Soundblaster 16 soundcard compatibility  
Stereo speakers or headphones

#### Macintosh

### INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

#### Windows

1. Start Microsoft Windows and insert *Virtual Clinical Excursions Disk 1 (Installation)* in the CD-ROM drive.
2. Click the **Start** button on the taskbar and select the **Run** option.
3. Type d:\setup.exe (where "d:\" is your CD-ROM drive) and press **OK**.
4. Follow the on-screen instructions for installation.
5. Remove *Virtual Clinical Excursions Disk 1 (Installation)* from your CD-ROM drive.
6. Restart your computer.

#### Macintosh

1. Insert *Virtual Clinical Excursions Disk 1 (Installation)* in the CD-ROM drive. The disk icon will appear on your desktop.

2. Double-click on the disk icon.
3. Double-click on the icon **Install Virtual Clinical Excursions**.
4. Follow the on-screen instructions for installation.
5. Remove *Virtual Clinical Excursions Disk 1 (Installation)* from your CD-ROM drive.
6. Restart your computer.

### HOW TO USE DISK 2 (PATIENTS' DISK)

#### Windows

When you want to work with the five patients in the virtual hospital, follow these steps:

1. Insert *Virtual Clinical Excursions Disk 2 (Patients' Disk)* into your CD-ROM drive.
2. Double-click on the icon **Shortcut to Virtual Clinical Excursions** which can be found on your desktop. This will load and run the program.

#### Macintosh

When you want to work with the five patients in the virtual hospital, follow these steps:

1. Insert *Virtual Clinical Excursions Disk 2 (Patients' Disk)* into your CD-ROM drive.

## HOW TO RESET YOUR MONITOR TO 256 COLORS

This software will only run if the monitor is set at 256 colors. To reset your monitor:

### Windows

1. Choose **Settings** from the **Start** menu.
2. Choose **Control Panel**.
3. Double-click on the **Display** icon.
4. Click on the **Settings** tab.
5. In the **Colors Palette** drop-down menu, click on the arrow to show more settings.
6. Click on **256 Color**.
7. Click on **Apply**.
8. Click on **OK**.

If the system asks whether you wish to restart your computer to accept these settings, click on **Yes**.

### Macintosh

1. Choose the **Monitors** control panel.
2. Change the color display to **256**.

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
