Course Description:

This course is designed primarily for students who have little or no prior exposure to Chinese. The objective of the course is to help students build a solid foundation of the four basic skills--listening, speaking, reading, and writing in an interactive and communicative learning environment. In order to achieve these goals, students are expected to thoroughly preview and review the materials according to the weekly

lesson plan (on course website) prior to attending class. Regular attendance is mandatory and strictly monitored. Students' final grade will be affected by their constant absence.

Format of Class:

The class is conducted in the manner of a combination of 1) explanation of vocabulary, grammar points, and text; 2) pattern practice, drill, and mini-dialogue; and 3) reading exercises, recitation, and improvisation; 3) vocabulary quizzes, chapter tests and oral and written exams.

Your final grade will be determined in the following way:

Class Participation: In addition to daily review and preparation outside of the classroom, constant listening and speaking exercises in class are required to learn the language well. Your regular participation is the key for you to obtain the maximum practice and it counts for 10% of your grade. In order to take full advantage of in-class participation, please come to class on time. Your active participation, rather than your physical being in the classroom, is what matters.

Quizzes: There will be 10 quizzes for this course. They count for 20% of your grade.

Chapter Tests: Normally tests will be given at the end of a lesson. They compose 20% of your final grade.

Homework: These make up 20% of your grade. You will be responsible for the completion of ALL of the homework indicated on the weekly schedule as well as those assigned by the instructor. All assignments are due on the next class day. Incomplete homework will be corrected but will not receive full credit. Late homework will not receive any credit. Your homework will be graded:

Final Oral Exam:

In order to develop students' listening and speaking ability, there will be a final oral exam in week 15 on Thursday. In the final oral exam, your teacher will ask you questions based on the text and you are expected to answer them in Chinese. The purpose of the oral tasks is two-fold: 1) to assist students to utilize learned vocabulary and grammatical structures, and 2) to gradually increase students' ability to communicate in Chinese. The final oral exam is graded according to the following criteria: pronunciation, tones, grammar, content and the overall preparedness.
